PVR Zoom Meeting Minutes

February 7, 2024

President Steven Perik, Jr., brought the meeting to order at 6:32 P.M. Present were Board members Scott Klein, Rick Bartel, Todd Persha, Eric Schuette, Brandon Gentz, and Kris Pecha. Eric Schuette – Reached out to Debbie regarding our Wausau race to make certain there were no outstanding bills for which PVR or its membership would be held responsible.

Dean Bennett – Absent

Rick Bartel – Nothing to report but has a heavy heart because the Manawa race had to be canceled due to the warm weather conditions that made the lake unsafe. Rick encouraged PVR members to support the Manawa snowmobile show on the 17th and 18th of February.

Tasha Bushy – Sent Steven an email - refund for Manawa.

Red flags from Wausau race taken care of.

Equipment Manager – Thanked the people who helped at Wausau.

Safety Manager – Scott Klein said ‘hats off’ to all racers for a safe race at Wausau.

Treasurer's Report – Deb Priebe was absent but told Steven we took in \$455.00 for pit passes at Wausau.

Secretary's Report – Kris emailed the Board members and Managers the January 30, 2024, meeting minutes.

Old/Unfinished Business – Steven asked the Board if they had any suggestions of how to improve upon the Wausau race. Eric suggested holding a two-day race there.

Unfinished Business – None

New Business – Raceciever issues. At Wausau, the Race Director disqualified two drivers because they did not respond to the red flag when called over the racecievers. They had passed two red flags and the head flagman had to flag them down to stop them because there was an accident on the track. (All drivers had stopped except the first two when the red flag was called,)

It was Todd Achterberg's opinion we wouldn't have to send them off track, that we should try to correct the issues.

When it becomes apparent that a raceceiver is not working, should a driver be given a two-minute warning to get his unit working? Steven also talked about the possibility of having extra raceceivers on hand.

The Board then discussed having a raceceiver check in the hot pits every other class. Jennifer advised USSA does raceceiver checks in staging.

Steven asked for a motion on the raceceiver ruling. Scott made a motion to follow the ISR rule; Brandon seconded the motion that drivers be given two minutes to plug in a spare unit that they carry with them.

Points- Regarding DQ's, the question was raised, should those drivers still be awarded five points for showing up?

Eric made a motion to give points to these two. Scott seconded the motion, motion carried.

Steven stated if a sled can't pass post inspection, they should not get the five show-up points.

Scott made a motion to rescind his second to the previous motion, Brandon seconded the motion to rescind, and that motion carried. A discussion ensued as follows: Steven reiterated if a sled can't pass post inspection, there's been bad driving or unsportsmanlike behavior by a driver or crew member(s), show-up points should not be awarded. Steven asked for a motion to that effect. Brandon made the motion, Eric seconded the motion, motion carried.

Brandon informed the Board Calvin Iverson wants to have a PVR race in Strum, WI next year. They would like to have it on a land track with barriers.

OCC – Race under contract for February 10, 2024, has been rescheduled to March 2, 2024.

Manawa – Under contract. Scheduled for the third weekend in February, which is the 17th and 18th. Due to unseasonably warm conditions, the race on the lake has been canceled.

Eagle River World's Series – Under contract. Scheduled for the last weekend in February, on the 24th and 25th.

People talking to Steven about racing on Saturday like maybe F-440, Champ, Sportsman 600, F-500, and Pro lite on Sunday morning with heats.

At a prior meeting there was a discussion about not holding PVR races on Saturday of the World Series. However, it's since been suggested we run several classes on Saturday. Brandon made a motion to race on Saturday and Sunday, Eric seconded the motion, motion carried.

Media Marketing – Colton will make fliers for the Manawa snowmobile show.

Promotion of Pro Vintage Racing – Steven gave Jim Lemke control of our Official PVR Facebook page to promote sponsors.

Next Board meeting will be held by Zoom on March 5, 2024, starting at 6:30 P.M.

Scott Klein made a motion to adjourn the meeting;
