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## **PVR Zoom Meeting Minutes**

### **October 3, 2023**

President Steven Perik, Jr., brought the meeting to order at 6:32 P.M. Present were Board members Scott Klein, Rick Bartel, Todd Persha, Eric Schuette, Dean Bennett, Brandon Gentz, Debbie Priebe and Kris Pecha.

#### **President's Report:**

**Steven Perik, Jr.,** – The status of Ironwood remains the same, no updates. Steven is working with the Ironwood Chamber and is getting to know Micheal Meyer.

Steven also talked to Rick Teide from Woody's about sponsorship.

**Dean Bennett** – Talked to Greg Bosum from Ironwood. The Gogebic County Fair Board will not commit to a 2024 race as they are still sorting out all issues and waiting to hear what is going to happen.

Manawa has scheduled a meeting on October 12th at 6:30 p.m. that he and Rick will be attending.

Discussion returned to Ironwood and whether or not there would be another venue available if Ironwood is cancelled. Steven suggested the Portage area as a possibility as there is interest in having a track there.

Brandon suggested locating another track and adding another race then announcing we are replacing Ironwood.

**Rick Bartel** – PVR documents that had been in the race trailer are now stored in his garage.

**Kris Pecha** – Stopped at 365 Motorsports and spoke to them about sponsorship. They will offer all PVR members 15% off a new helmet and will also do something for our February 3, 2024, PVR Wausau race.
